

School Board Summary
September 20, 2005

1. The meeting was called to order by President Sherie Rondeau with all members present.
2. The Board heard a discussion of the FIRST (Financial Integrity Rating System of Texas) for the district for 2003-2004. The district had an superior rating with all indicators being answered yes.
3. The handbooks for the junior high and high school band programs were approved as presented.
4. Consent agenda items were accepted. Mr. Nightingale said that the district had over a 100% tax collection rate due to the amount of back taxes that had been collected.
5. Becky Rodgers was added to the substitute teacher list.
6. First readings were held for local policies dealing with nonschool use of school facilities, distribution of nonschool literature, distribution of nonschool literature by students, and nonschool use of school facilities by students.
7. Ben Segler was named to the Board to fill the vacancy left by the resignation of Joe Coffey.
8. An evaluation of last year's district and campus plans was held.
9. Plans for the 2005-2006 year were approved.
10. Superintendent's report
 - A. Enrollment-The district has 584 students in attendance with an ADA of 569. The budget is based on an ADA of 560.
 - B. Drug testing program-A representative of the company that will be conducting the program has met with each principal to go over procedures. Plans for the first test are in place.
 - C. Convention-The convention has been postponed due to the threat of a hurricane hitting Houston.
 - D. Board training-Level II training has been set for October 13 at Region 9.
11. Keith Jeeter was employed as a special education teacher for the AEP.
