

School Board Summary  
November 15, 2005

1. The meeting was called to order by President Sherie Rondeau. Other trustees present included Kay Whisnand, Kelly DeLizio, Ben Segler and Wayne Cranford.
2. The Board approved the resale of two pieces of property owned by the district to Benny Bowden and Ronnie Baize.
3. Consent agenda items were accepted as presented.
4. Jennifer Monroe was added to the substitute teacher list.
5. Budget amendments were approved. There was no increase to the budget.
6. The second reading and adoption of local policies in Update 76 was held.
7. Approval of early release on Wednesday, January 11, was given to write the final PBMAS report.
8. Superintendent's Report
  - A. Mr. Nightingale stated that the review of the Child Nutrition Program that was held on October 21 went well.
  - B. He reviewed his plan to replace the vans and school car.
  - C. A discussion of the PBMAS findings for our special education program was presented.
  - D. He said that the final arrangements for the random testing of students who participate in extra curricular activities have been completed, and the company that will do the testing is ready to begin the process.
