

School Board Summary
September 19, 2006

1. The meeting was conducted by Mrs. Rondeau with all members present.
2. Trustees heard a request from Logan Irwin to have the student dress code changed to allow boys to wear earrings. He presented a petition that contained 55 names. He was told that the matter would be taken under advisement.
3. Approval was given for the tax resale deed for property described as Lot 1, Block 8, Southland Addition. The bid was submitted by Douglas Monroe.
4. Consent agenda items were approved as presented.
5. The names of June Defoor, Jennifer Hudson, and Kimberly O'Neal were added to the substitute teacher list.
6. Joshua Brown, Jessica Flores and Joseph Flores were approved as transfer students.
7. Trustees approved first reading of policy BE (Local) that would change regular board meetings to the third Monday of each month.
8. Approval was granted to change October's meeting from the 17th to the 24th.
9. Evaluations of last year's plans were presented, and approval of 2006-2007 plans was given.
10. Members approved an interlocal agreement with Tarrant County for purchasing items. This is a regional buy board which will allow the district to make purchases without having to go through the bidding process. There was no cost to join.
11. Superintendent's report:
 - A. Enrollment now stands at 548 as compared to 550 at the start of the year.
 - B. Mr. Nightingale gave a report on the district's vehicles. He noted age, mileage and condition of each. He reminded trustees that \$100,000 had been designated for updating the district's fleet. He has ordered a 53 passenger bus. Delivery is expected in about six months. He also wants to purchase a suburban and a pickup. Cost of these three may be a little over \$100,000.
 - C. He presented information on training opportunities for members.
12. The board went into closed meeting. Upon their return, the resignation of Larry Ludtke was accepted to be effective at the end of the current year.
13. There being no further business for consideration, the meeting was adjourned.
