Pre-K & Kindergarten Roundup for 2020-2021 WELCOME TO ELECTRA ELEMENTARY

We are looking forward to signing up new students for Pre-K and Kindergarten for the 2020-2021 school year! Unfortunately, due to COVID-19, we will not be able to meet with you face to face, but you and your child will be able to visit our school in July to complete the registration process. This year's registration will be done in a two step process. First, we ask that you complete the Early Registration Form as soon as possible. Second, one of our staff will contact you to schedule an appointment to complete the registration process.

You *do not* need to register your child if he/she is already enrolled in Electra Pre-K or Kindergarten classes.

PRE-K QUALIFICATIONS

A free full day pre-kindergarten program is available for children who are four years old by September 1. Electra ISD pre-kindergarten is consistent with the Texas High-Quality Prekindergarten program requirements. This means that we maintain a 11 to 1 student to teacher ratio, all our Pre-K Teachers are High Quality certified, and a research-based curriculum is used.

To Qualify for Pre-K students must meet one of the following criteria:

- Is unable to speak and comprehend the English language; or
- Is educationally disadvantaged (which means a student eligible to participate in the national free or reduced-priced lunch program).
- Is homeless, as defined by 42 U.S.C. Section 1143a, regardless of the residence of the child, of either parent of the child, or of the child's guardian or other person having lawful control of the child; or
- Is the child of an active duty member of the armed forces of the United states, including the state military forces or a reserve component of the armed forces, who is ordered to active duty by proper authority; or
- Is or ever has been in the conservatorship of the Department of Family and Protective Services (foster care) following an adversary hearing held as provided by Section 262.201, Family Code; or
- Is the child of a person eligible for the Star Of Texas Award as: a peace officer under Section 3106.002, Government Code; a firefighter under Section 3106.003, Government Code; or an emergency medical first responder under Section 3106.004, Government Code

Pre-K Required Documentation that you will need to provide in July to complete the Registration Process:

1. Child's Birth Certificate
2. Proof of residence—(Utility bill with parent/ guardians physical address)
3. Up to date Immunization Record
4. Social security Card
5. Parent's) Drivers License

6. Proof of income: (2019 Income Tax Return)

If no tax return, other acceptable documents are:

~Child Support Statement

~SSI Statement

~TANF Statement

~2-3 recent paycheck stubs

~Unemployment statement

~Student Loan information

7. Proof of Guardianship (If Applicable)

8. Foster Care Placement Form, Guardianship Court Order or Power of Attorney (if applicable)
