REMEDICATION INSTRUCTIONS

- All students should be enrolled in a Google Classroom by **Monday, March 30th at 8:00 am**. In order to access the Google Classroom, students should check their district-issued email for a link to connect them. If students do not remember the password for their email, they may reset their password using the link on our district website. **The purpose of the Google Classroom is to establish a connection between the teachers and students.**
- Students' 5th Six Weeks' grades will be the grade that is in the gradebook as of **Monday, March 30th at 8:00 am**. To access your student's grades, please visit our district website.
- If your student has an average below 70% in any class, the teacher will make contact with the student's parent to establish ways the student can receive remediation and new work to raise his/her grade to a satisfactory level. This contact will be made no later than **Monday, March 30th at 4:00 pm**.
- In the event that a student's average is above 70%, and the student would like to raise his/her average, the student must initiate contact with the teacher in order to receive remediation and new work in order to raise his/her average. This contact needs to be made no later than **Monday, March 30th at 4:00 pm**.
- All work for the 5th Six Weeks must be submitted to the teacher on or before **Friday at 3:45**.
